

We have acted for a company in the fuel cell sector for many years and worked with them to grow their portfolio. From small beginnings we developed a close relationship with both their in-house team and the inventors to grow their patent portfolio.

We were able to use our experience of control technologies, electronics and materials to support them fully as the scope of their R&D expanded from fundamental structure, to manufacturing techniques, system level control systems, hybrid power systems and consumer electronic products.

We were asked to manage the patent portfolio of a company which is involved in the preparation of minerals for use in the construction industry using routes which are carbon neutral.

The construction industry is a major generator of carbon dioxide, and the reduction of carbon in this sector has the scope to have a significant impact on global emissions. We are working with that company to implement a patent strategy which will both maximise the uptake of the technology in the construction industry and optimise the possibilities for adoption of the technology in other areas, including the removal of carbon from the atmosphere.



HELPING A GREEN HYDROGEN TECHNOLOGY BUSINESS CREATE THE SOLID IP FOUNDATION THEY NEEDED TO SECURE FUNDING AND ACHIEVE THEIR COMMERCIAL POTENTIAL

The solicitors and attorneys in our cleantech team advise a rapidly growing sustainable energy manufacturer pioneering the use of green hydrogen technology. As they grew, the client required increasingly diverse support.


They collaborated with major industry specialists during key investment rounds and their board required increasingly complex strategic IP advice as they prepared to take the next steps in their development.

Potter Clarkson audited the client's existing IP portfolios. The resulting report outlined the status of their respective IP rights and provided a frank assessment of their existing IP strategy, making recommendations as to where it could be improved. We also analysed their main competitors and their technologies, highlighting potential areas of dispute.

Our report provided broad-ranging and decision-ready advice in respect of their most important issues including:

- How IP issues should be dealt with (including the establishment of an IP committee reporting into the board).
- The timing and scope of the FTO searches needed to mitigate the potential risk of litigation.
- Advice on how to manage and protect their trade secrets using our SafeGuard product.
- The merits and drawbacks of insuring their IP portfolio.

Our advice to date has directly contributed to our client securing the investment they needed and enabled their hydrogen technology to achieve its enormous commercial potential.



In cleantech there are often clear distinctions between the needs of large companies and the needs of start-ups and smaller entities and micro-entities. It is therefore necessary to tailor an IP portfolio that matches the needs and size of the applicant entities.

We recently worked with a small but ambitious and fast-growing client in the biochar sector.

Our client had developed a new reaction vessel and data monitoring method that vastly improves the effectiveness of small-scale biochar production in remote and distributed locations such as within smallholder farming communities in the developing world.

Straight away it was decided not to try and protect the basic science underpinning biochar production for this client. As there weren't strong patenting prospects, there was a high risk of high patent prosecution costs and/or low granting rates. Instead, our suggested strategy included a patenting programme focussed on remote data acquisition and handling and a portfolio of registered designs aimed at protecting the appearance of the novel reactor vessel they created.

The patenting side of this strategy emphasises our client's unique contribution to the science of biochar production and represents a much better use of the company's limited IP budget while the registered designs have allowed us to provide a measure of protection at low cost and in a short timescale.


